Terms & conditions, grants related to SDG 6 and SDG 14 (2018)

By submitting an application for an alumni event grant you comply with the below terms and conditions:

- No more than one application per person may be submitted per open call.
- Only <u>SI alumni</u> from Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Estonia, Georgia, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Poland, Russia and Ukraine are eligible to apply.
- Incomplete applications will not be assessed.
- The activity cannot be held earlier January 2019
- The grant cannot be used for any profitable business or start-up.
- The grant cannot be used to fund any organisation's regular operations.
- The activity cannot be carried out by one single individual but should have at least two organisers.
- We might share your application with the Swedish embassy in your country.
- Priority will be given to activities which are in line with SI's vision that alumni should actively contribute to a fair and sustainable global development.
- The expected **impact** of the activity, the **quality** of the application and the **relevance** of the activity in relation to the local context will be the main parameters in SI's assessment of the applications. Other factors that may increase your chances of receiving an event grant are collaborations with the local alumni network (if there is one) and the Swedish embassy, and connections to Sweden (such as Swedish speakers, or showcasing Swedish experience in a certain field).
- Alumni activities can have external partners (NGOs, universities, companies). However, the SI grants are not intended to finance your own company, NGO or university's activities.
- Grant recipients must submit a post-event report including photos, programme and list of participants. An evaluation form must also be completed.
- The Swedish Institute has the mandate to withdraw the grant at any time should any of the above terms and conditions not be followed.
- The Swedish Institute is a Swedish public agency, which means that any document is open to and can be requested by the general public
