Swedish-Turkish Scholarship Programme and SI Scholarships for the Western Balkans 2019/2020

Thank you for applying for a Swedish Institute scholarship. We received **550** applications from **212** applicants. **127** of these candidates were admitted to a master programme and were eligible for an SI scholarship: 7 from Albania, 2 from Bosnia and Herzegovina, 4 from Kosovo, 1 from Montenegro, 7 from North Macedonia, 6 from Serbia and 100 from Turkey. **18** are selected for a scholarship and **4** are placed on the reserve list.
