## Terms & conditions She Entrepreneurs alumni grants

**By submitting an application for an alumni grant you comply with the below terms and conditions:**

- Only alumni of the Swedish Institute She Entrepreneurs programme are eligible to apply.
- Incomplete applications will not be assessed.
- Applications should be submitted at least eight weeks prior to the planned activity.
- The grant cannot be used for any for profit events.
- The grant cannot be used to fund any business or organisation's regular operations.
- The activity cannot be carried out by one single individual but should have at least two organisers.
- We might share your application with the Swedish embassy in your country.
- Alumni activities can have external partners (NGOs, universities, companies). However, the SI grants are not intended to finance your own company, NGO or university's activities.
- Grant recipients must submit a post-event report including photos, programme and list of participants. An evaluation form must also be completed.
- The Swedish Institute has the mandate to withdraw the grant at any time should any of the above terms and conditions not be followed.
- The Swedish Institute is a Swedish public agency, which means that any document is open to and can be requested by the general public.
